Ceroc in Scotland are proud to announce their 3rd Scottish Ceroc Competition in aid of **The PBC Foundation (UK) Ltd.**

The PBC Foundation (UK) Ltd is a nationwide charity providing information, support and help to sufferers of PBC and those close to them.

PBC (Primary Biliary Cirrhosis) is a relentlessly progressive condition, which has no known cause, or cure, and there is no acknowledged medication to halt its progression. There is very little by way of medication to treat the symptoms of PBC and not all patients may respond positively. PBC is considered to be an autoimmune liver disease and is one of the main reasons for liver transplantation, although PBC can and does return in a few. 90% of PBC sufferers are women and it is thought to affect one in one thousand.

Your valued support will help us to: support our national help-line; improve the quality of life for PBC sufferers; educate the general public and all health professionals; find a cause and cure for PBC.

The Brunton Hall in Musselburgh has a great dance floor. In addition food and drink will be available to keep you going throughout the day & night.

Doors open Midday and the Competition kicks off at 1.00pm sharp. Events continue throughout the day, with plenty of freestyle for everyone at regular intervals. Then from 7.30pm until midnight it's Party time, featuring the finals, prizes and presentations ending with freestyle for all.

As this event is being run in aid of the PBC Foundation the emphasis of the event will be on the fun of participation and the potential glory of winning a category rather than as a serious competition for prizes of considerable value. By competing in this event competitors will be contributing significantly to the charitable work carried out by **The PBC Foundation (UK) Ltd.**

NB: To ensure that there is sufficient room for people to dance the number of tickets for this event will be limited to **550**. So please book early so that you are not disappointed...

The Categories

In these categories judges will be looking for style and musical interpretation rather than the number / difficulty of moves. The lead and follow aspect of the moves must be clearly demonstrated. With the exception of the Team Cabaret & Open Freestyle couples should not attempt to dance set routines and lifts, jumps and acrobatic moves will not be permitted. Drops are permitted provided that the ball of one of the lady's feet remains in contact with the floor. Points will be awarded for dress and presentation.

NB: The categories Intermediate & Advanced are not open to professionally trained/paid teachers.

Intermediate Freestyle

(Entry fee £ 16 per couple + admission). This section is recommended for those who have danced for six months or more but do not wish to compete with the Advanced Dancers. Dancers from the Advanced Freestyle Section will not be permitted to enter this section.

1st Prize: £100 + Winners Certificate

Advanced Freestyle

(Entry fee £ 16 per couple + admission). This section is open to anyone that wants to compete with the best. Dancers from the Intermediate Freestyle Section will not be permitted to enter this section.

1st Prize: £ 100 + Winners Certificate

Team Cabaret

(Entry fee £ 30 per team + admission). (Please provide additional details as specified). In this section dancers choose their own piece of music between three and six minutes long and perform their own choreography. Each team must be between three and 10 couples. Points will be awarded for dress and presentation as well as choreography, musical interpretation and dancing style.

1st Prize: Bottles of Champagne + Winners Certificate

Double Trouble

(Entry fee £ 16 per team + admission). (Please provide additional details as specified). In this section a team should consist of three people in any combination of male/female dancers. The dancing must be continuous but the lead is allowed to change from one partner to another. Points will be awarded for dress and presentation.

1st Prize: £ 100 + Winners Certificate

Lucky Dip

(Entry fee £ 5 per person + admission). No partner required for this section. No one knows who their partner will be until the day itself; they may be a complete stranger- they may not! They may be a good dancer – they may not! Partners will be allocated on the day.

1st Prize: £ 50 + Winners Certificate

Open Freestyle

(Entry fee £ 16 per couple + admission). This section is open to anyone that wants to compete with no restrictions. Jumps and acrobatic moves will be permitted and dancers may compete in this as well as any other category e.g. Intermediate, Advanced....

1st Prize: £ 100 + Winners Certificate

Pre-Competition Party Fri 13th Aug

In conjunction with this event Ceroc in Scotland will be running a Pre-Competition party so that you can warm up for the main event. Tickets maybe purchased at regular Edinburgh or Dundee nights or can be purchased as part of this application. Party will start 8pm and will be held in the The Brunton Hall, Musselburgh, Edinburgh.
